Aperture is a multifunctional tool that combines all aspects of photography and image editing (see Chapter 5 for more on software with these features). Avid: Avid ([`www.avid.com`](http://www.avid.com)) is a company that specializes in video-editing software. At the time of this writing, it is no longer available for download. However, it is still being sold and it is quite expensive, so it's probably best to check your local computer store for it. It has a wide array of features and is recognized as one of the world's most popular video-editing programs. Finale: Finale ([`www.finale.com`](http://www.finale.com)) is one of the more expensive editors that are available today. Finale is used to create screenplays, website designs, print designs, and so on. ImageReady: The number one basic graphics program in the world today is Adobe's ImageReady, which is a suite of graphics programs. This is the only tool that is always open in Photoshop Elements; you can close it at any time. 5. Select a Photoshop Studio You can choose the username for Photoshop Elements or create a new one. Name the Photoshop Studio something creative, such as "Repairman." Your Photoshop Studio will be a home for all your files. It will not be used for anything else. It is intended for use within Photoshop Elements, just like a folder for a folder for folders. 6. Click Next Click Next to proceed to the next step. 7. The Healing Brush, Magnetic Lasso, Spot Healing Brush, and AirBrush tools are used to edit and apply complex color and texture changes to images. The Pen tools allow you to draw freehand or use any pre-defined artwork as a guide in drawing. They can be used to create various effects, such as splatter, scribble, graffiti, writing, etc. You can create or customize your own brushes and make adjustments to their settings. You can also customize a wide range of basic and more advanced options and parameters. The Photoshop interface is laid out using a group of panels, folders and tools. Each tool is represented by a graphics icon on the top of the panel. For example, the Rectangle tool, with its thick, green handle, looks like the tool shown below. The work area in Photoshop is known as the Photoshop document. At the center of the work area is the Toolbox. It contains icons for tools that you're using and options for those tools. You can move icons around and put them into groups, called panels. You can also manipulate the position of the panels so that you can easily access the most important tools. The Pen tool, the largest and most commonly used tool, can be found on the left of the Photoshop interface, below the name of the current document. Tool Types There are a number of different types of tools in Photoshop that can be used for different effects. In the Toolbox, you'll find icons that represent each type of tool. Most of the common tools are listed in the Help menu. There are other, more complex tools available as well. These are discussed in the chapters of this book. Rectangle Tool The Rectangle tool is usually represented as the green rectangle shown here. It can also be called a Rectangle tool. Dividers The Dividers are a set of three small, circular icons shown here. The three Dividers are used for divisions, or where one area is divided from another. Dot and Inner Border The Dot tool is represented by the small black dot. It is used to add and subtract, or change the size of any pixel in an image. The Dot tool also creates a set of white dots, or inner border, around the selected area. Dot Drop Shadow The Dot Drop Shadow is a special tool that allows you to selectively add an image as a drop shadow to an existing image.
